Dear Customer:

According to our policy of maximum responsibility on legislative issues, GMI S.L. hereby reports on the steps that have been taken (according to the European regulation 1907/2006) concerning the registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemicals otherwise known as REACH. REACH regulations are intended to ensure a high level of human health protection, environmental protection, and the free movement of substances.

REGISTRATION AND COMMUNICATION ON THE USE OF SUBSTANCES:

As intermediate users GMI have been and are in contact with our suppliers to ensure that appropriate steps have been taken with respect to the suppliers obligations under the REACH regulations regarding the products they provide to us.

Our suppliers have confirmed to GMI their compliance with the REACH regulations for the substances GMI uses, either through the registry or through the pre-registration for those substances whose registration deadline ends in 2018. GMI has also provided information to its suppliers about the use of the substances supplied to ensure that these uses are included and identified in the registration of substances.

SUBSTANCES OF VERY HIGH CONCERN (SVHC). Annex XIV REACH:

In terms of the SVHC, the suppliers of substances or substances contained in mixtures or in articles present in the candidate list of substances for authorization, in concentrations higher than 0.1%, must provide to their customers enough information to be able to have safe use and at least;

- a) the name of the substance, in the case of articles, and
- b) a safety data sheet in the case of substances and mixtures.

GMI has consulted with its suppliers and can confirm that there is no SVHC in the products supplied to us above the 0.1% level according to the latest update published by ECHA on the 20th of June 2013.
